Appendix B.

Traffic and Parking Management

Plan It shall be the responsibility of the College to manage Event traffic.

Following is a list of the activities the Events Management Office will undertake:

1. The College will assist Event sponsors who wish to implement available off-site parking, shuttle bus or car pool programs.
2. Service providers for Events, e.g., photographers, musical groups; florists; caterers, rental equipment delivery services, will be routed via Locust between Grand and Magnolia, then onto Magnolia. This routing will be provided to Event sponsors with the Event contract and will be communicated to all service providers engaged by the Event sponsor. (This refers specifically to special Events non-food delivery, not to routine delivery traffic coming to and going from the College.)
3. Valet parking will not be allowed at Caleruega, the Chapel, or Angelico Concert Hall. Drop-offs for Angelico Concert Hall will be limited to handicapped persons, and shall be controlled by the Events Management Office to ensure that all such drop-offs are directed away from the near-by residences.
4. Buses will be directed by the traffic control personnel to avoid residential streets where possible, to wait in designated lots, and to avoid waiting with idling engines.
5. In accordance with the requirements of the San Rafael Police Department, during Phase I, the number of people arriving by private vehicle for Events and/or College Activities shall not exceed 1,000 persons, except at the following times or under the following conditions:
 - o Annual College commencement and/or convocation ceremonies;
 - o College sponsored intercollegiate athletic tournaments or playoffs;
 - o When permitted in advance by the San Rafael Police Department or by obtaining a Special Use Permit from the City of San Rafael.
6. If permitted by the City of San Rafael, erect a barrier near to exit from the College parking lot onto Belle Avenue which prevents exiting traffic from turning left onto Belle Avenue. Further, if permitted by the City of San Rafael, during Events, monitor and direct traffic to ensure that vehicular or pedestrian traffic does not enter from Belle Avenue the parking lot located at Belle and Grand Avenues.
