Parking: No permit is required for the Conlan Recreation Center lot. Other campus parking requires a permit only Mon-Fri until 5pm. Please observe signs.

Class drop/add: You may add a class with instructor signature by January 30 or drop by January 23 for full tuition refund. Neither requires an advisor signature, but it is best to consult one about the effects of changes on your degree and financial aid.

ID cards and email account: Obtain your free Penguin Pass from Information Technology in the Alemany Library. A student email account is mandatory to ensure you receive official announcements, and you can link it to your home or work email address.

Health Insurance: All students must be insured. February 11 is the deadline for providing proof of medical insurance to the Business Services Office, Bertrand 103, or you will be charged for the student health plan.
