Teacher of the Year Award

Sarlo Distinguished Professor Award

Description of Teacher of the Year Award

This is a teaching award to a faculty member nominated by Dominican College students. The faculty member may be a full-time or part-time teacher who has demonstrated outstanding performance as a teacher. Award of \$1,000.

Criteria for the Teacher of the Year Award

- Full-time faculty member, chair or dean or
 - Adjunct faculty hired before 9/1/99 who:
1. Make a discernible difference in the lives of students and the campus climate through inspiring teaching and mentoring;
 2. Be a model classroom teacher, diligent, creative, and successful in teaching methodology and course development;
 3. Be respected and admired by students and colleagues for consistently superior teaching;
 4. Be professionally active and generous in service to the College.
 5. Previous recipients are not eligible.

Description of the Sarlo Distinguished Professor Award

This is a lifetime achievement award for a professor who has brought distinction to Dominican College. The recipient of this honor is a full-time faculty member who has consistently demonstrated outstanding performance as a teacher, has offered significantly to their community, and has served as a prominent leader in their academic or professional area. Award of \$5,000.

Criteria for the Sarlo Distinguished Professor Award

- Faculty member, chair, or dean who holds the rank of Full Professor, who has been employed full-time at the College for a minimum of 12 years and who:
1. Is an outstanding teacher fulfilling the criteria of the Teacher of the Year Award:

Make a discernible difference in the lives of students and the campus climate through inspiring teaching and mentoring;
Be a model classroom teacher, diligent, creative, and successful in teaching methodology and course development;
Be respected and admired by students and colleagues for consistently superior teaching;
Be professionally active and generous in service to the College.
 2. Brought distinction to the College in at least two of the following ways: a) Research, publication and/or scholarship, b) Community service, c) Leadership of distinguished academic program.
 3. Has served as a significant leader as recognized by colleagues at Dominican, and peers outside of the immediate College community, as having made significant contributions to their respective academic and/or professional area.
 4. Is generous of spirit and has consistently given his or her time and energy with both colleagues and students.
 5. Has fostered students' intellectual and professional development through the liberal arts
 6. Has contributed to furthering the College's appreciation of cultural diversity and global interdependence through interdisciplinary

initiatives.

All criteria must be accomplished
Nominations by students only.

Minimum criteria #1, 2 & 3 must be accomplished
Nominations by any member of the College Community.
