

Master's Degrees – Dominican University of California *formerly Dominican College of San Rafael*

*In 1924, Dominican College of San Rafael was licensed by the State of California to offer teaching credential programs. Additionally, from 1932 – 1967, Dominican College of San Rafael functioned as the Pacific Branch of Catholic University of America, hosting graduate summer programs in various disciplines including English, French, Greek, Latin, History and Religion/Theology. These early forays into post-baccalaureate education eventually culminated in the formation of Dominican's own graduate school in 1950. What follows is a **chronological** listing of graduate degrees offered by Dominican University of California over the past fifty-seven years.*
