All creationisms, the intelligent design variety included, are at bottom theology pretending to be science. The federal courts in Pennsylvania will undoubtedly find as much in the Dover biology case currently on trial.

Both the theology and the science are incoherent, which leads to the question what might a better theology look like. The answers are very interesting.

The doctrine of creation is not about cosmogony; it gets its cosmogonies from the surrounding culture. Creation is about the goodness of the world. Creationists don't understand that, and so they think have to interfere with evolutionary biology.
