



## Liberal Studies/Teacher Preparation Program Fieldwork Expectations

A **minimum of 20 hours** of fieldwork is required **each semester**.

Fieldwork hours are to be distributed throughout the semester.

This is based on a routine schedule of same day/time each week.

Students are required to provide the LS instructor with their Fieldwork Schedule.

### Reliability and Promptness:

Students are expected to be **on time** to Fieldwork.

### Absence from Fieldwork:

Other than in a case of emergency, **no absences** are allowed.

In the event of an emergency, students **must notify** the school and the fieldwork

teacher and the LS instructor of an absence **prior** to the absence.

### Attire during Fieldwork:

Fieldwork is not only an LS Program requirement, it is a professional experience.

Students need to **wear appropriate attire** during Fieldwork.

### Confidentiality:

Students will **maintain confidentiality** regarding all aspects of the school where they are observing (students/teachers/parents/all personnel/school itself)

### Placements:

One private school placement (one semester) is allowed

Placements need to reflect the diversity of California schools

Students remain at a school site for one year in a different classroom each semester

LS 2000/3000 or 2001/3001: at least one placement in an upper grade classroom

Students enrolled in EDUC 3029 require placement in a K-2 classroom.

While in the school placement, students are expected to be **engaged in a variety of activities** to include:

- structured observations,
- supervised instruction or tutoring of students,
- activities that are appropriate for LS students as determined by the classroom teacher.

*Students will maintain fieldwork documentation (Field Experience Log and Fieldwork History). In addition, each Seminar Instructor will describe any other Fieldwork assignments/expectations related to that specific Liberal Studies seminar.*
