**Dominican announces financial aid opportunities!
Fellowships are available for new
MS in Counseling Psychology students.**

- Dominican will award an unlimited number of renewable need-based fellowships.
- Students may receive a maximum of \$1500 per semester (\$3000 annually). This fellowship does *not* apply to summer enrollment.
- Students who have been admitted to the program and who have filed the required financial aid papers by **December 1** (spring semester), and **July 1** (fall semester), will be considered for these fellowships.
- Students must enroll in a minimum of nine units per semester to maintain eligibility for the fellowship. Award recipients must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Students are required to work in the Department of Counseling for ten hours per semester.
- Students must apply using the FAFSA (fafsa.ed.gov) and Dominican Financial Aid Application (available online at www.dominican.edu), and provide any other required documents pertaining to establishing their eligibility for financial aid.
- For renewal, students must reapply each year and meet the need, deadline and enrollment criteria.
