Scholarships and grants are available for our new MS  
Education students.**

Scholarships

- Dominican will award a limited number of merit-based, non-renewable scholarships for the fall and spring semesters. This scholarship does *not* apply to summer enrollment.
- All students who have been admitted to the program by **December 1** (for the spring semester), or **July 1** (for the fall semester), will be considered for the awards.

Grants

- Dominican will award an unlimited number of non-renewable, need-based grants for the fall and spring semesters.
- Students may receive a maximum of \$1000 per semester (\$2000 annually). This scholarship does *not* apply to summer enrollment.
- Students who have been admitted and who have filed the required financial aid papers by **December 1** (spring semester), or **July 1** (fall semester) will be considered for the grants.
- Students must enroll in a minimum of nine units per semester to be eligible for the grant. Award recipients must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- Students must apply using the FAFSA (fafsa.ed.gov) and Dominican Financial Aid Application (available online at [www.dominican.edu](http://www.dominican.edu)), and provide any other required documents pertaining to establishing their eligibility for financial aid.
