**Dominican announces financial aid opportunities!
Grants are available for
MS in Occupational Therapy students.**

- Dominican will award an unlimited number of renewable need-based grants.
- Students may receive a maximum of \$1500 per semester (\$3000 annually). This grant does *not* apply to summer enrollment.
- Students who have been admitted and who have filed the required financial aid papers by **July 1**, will be considered for the grants.
- Students must enroll in a minimum of nine units per semester to maintain eligibility for the grant. Award recipients must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- Students must apply using the FAFSA (fafsa.ed.gov) and Dominican Financial Aid Application (available online at www.dominican.edu), and provide any other required documents pertaining to establishing their eligibility for financial aid.
- For renewal, students must reapply each year and meet the need, deadline and enrollment criteria.
