Priority Application Deadlines: For ADN-to-MSN track students, the priority deadline is November 15 for a Spring semester start. For BSN to MSN, the priority deadline is May 15 for Fall semester start.

Dominican University of California will evaluate the following admission application documents and determine the applicant's admission to the University.

## A complete admissions file must contain:

- 1. Completed Application for Admission
- 2. For the ADN-to-MSN track, an Associates degree in Nursing or its equivalent from a regionally accredited institution of higher learning. For the BSN-to-MSN track, a bachelor's degree or its equivalent from a regionally accredited institution of higher learning.
- 3. Official transcript of course work from each college or university attended (undergraduate and graduate). Transcripts must be in a sealed envelope sent directly from the college or university. Students who received their undergraduate degrees from an institution outside the United States should contact the Office of Admissions for further instructions. A grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 is required for the last 60 units of graded undergraduate or graduate course work.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation (academic or professional, on letterhead)
- 5. Resume
- 6. Statement of Purpose or Intent—a brief essay (500 words) describing professional and or personal goals and reasons for obtaining a graduate degree
- 7. Photocopy of current California RN license
- 8. Interview with the admissions committee (as needed)

In addition, all BSN to MSN track candidates are expected to have satisfied the following pre-requisite requirements for admission:

- 1. Statistics, within the past 5 years, with a grade of "B" (3.0) or higher
- 2. Nursing research, within the past 5 years, with a grade of "B" (3.0) or higher
