

Santa Rosa Junior College General Education Articulation Agreement (2012-2013)

General Education requirements are based on whether the student is enrolled in the Day or Adult Degree Completion Program (ADCP). Unless specified, Day and ADCP G.E. requirements are identical. All General Education requirements must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Please note that while some classes may appear to satisfy more than one area requirement, each class may only be applied to a single area.

First Year Experience must be completed at DUC if transfer student has 15 units or less

Day:

Requirement may be met by taking one course in A and B with at least one of these courses including a lab. After matriculation lecture and lab are required for both categories.

Adult Degree Completion Program:

Requirement is met by taking one course in either Biological or Physical Science with or without a lab before matriculation. **After** matriculation lecture and lab are required.

Creative and Performing Arts

Requirement may be met by taking any 3 unit course or by taking three 1 unit courses listed below.

Requirement is met by taking a 3 unit World's Religion course.

Colloquium - Day

Requirement is met by taking 6 upper division units at DUC <u>unless</u> transfer student has 45+ transferable units before matriculation. Any remaining units must be taken at DUC.

Unit requirement based on number of transferable units:

- *Transfer students with 0-44 transferable units must complete units at DUC.
- *Transfer students with 45-69 transferable units may select 1 course from below.
- *Transfer students with 70+ units are exempt.

Interdisciplinary Study - ADCP

Requirement is met by taking 6 upper division units at DUC <u>unless</u> student selects 1 or 2 courses listed below or in Day section before matriculation. Any remaining units must be taken at DUC.

Unit requirement based on number of transferable units:

- *Transfer students with 0-44 transferable units may select 2 courses.
- *Transfer students with 45-69 transferable units may select 1 course.
- *Transfer students with 70+ units are exempt.
