11. Cultural Heritage Colloquium (Day)/Interdisciplinary Study (Pathways)*	
Three interrelated 3-unit courses that investigate a particular era, theme, or geographical area (9 units total).	Courses in the following disciplines will fulfill this requirement: Art History, Comparative Religion, Ethnic Studies, History, History of the Natural Sciences, Humanities, International Relations, Literature including the literature of other languages, Philosophy, Political Theory, etc.

Transfer day students may fulfill the CHC requirement with transferable courses if they have 45+ transferable units or second degree students. Any units not fulfilled at transfer will need to be fulfilled at Dominican University of California at the upper division level. Transfer day students with less than 45 transferable units will need to complete the full CHC requirement at Dominican University of California.
