This agreement is only valid prior to transfer. There are certain limits on off-campus coursework once a student has matriculated. For complete descriptions of general education curricular goals please refer to the Dominican University of California (2008-2010) catalog under the General Education Program. Please note that while some classes may appear to satisfy more than one area requirement, each class may only be applied to a single area.

* General Education requirement is based on whether student is enrolled in Day (traditional) or Pathways (evening/weekend) degree program. Unless specified, Day and Pathways G.E. requirements are identical.

11. Cultural Heritage Colloquium (Day)/Interdisciplinary Study (Pathways)*	
<p>Three interrelated 3-unit courses that investigate a particular era, theme, or geographical area (9 units total).</p>	<p>Courses in the following disciplines will fulfill this requirement: Art History, Comparative Religion, Ethnic Studies, History, History of the Natural Sciences, Humanities, International Relations, Literature including the literature of other languages, Philosophy, Political Theory, etc.</p>

Transfer day students may fulfill the CHC requirement with transfer courses if they have 45+ transferable units or second degree students. Any units not fulfilled at transfer will need to be fulfilled at Dominican University of California at the upper division level. Transfer day students with less than 45 transferable units will need to complete the full CHC requirement at Dominican University of California.
