NURSING MAJOR PROGRAM PLAN FOR COMPLETION OF BSN REQUIREMENTS

- Based on placement exam results, additional coursework in English (e.g., WRIT 1001/1002), math (e.g., Math 1300), or chemistry (e.g., CHEM 1500/05) may be required.
- Transfer students follow a somewhat different program plan for General Education (see transfer course evaluation).
- Honors students take FYE 2000 and NURS 4998.
- Minimum grade in prerequisite and co-requisite classes is a C with the exception of Human Anatomy and Physiology (min. grade is a B). Minimum grade in NURS/NURL is a C+. Students who do not pass more than one class required for the nursing major (i.e., prerequisite, co-requisite, or Nursing) are disqualified from the nursing program.
