## Canada: Our Most Important Trading Partner

The United States and Canada enjoy the largest trading relationship in the world. Canada is easily our most significant customer, ahead of both China and Mexico. Integrated Canada-US supply chains contribute substantially to job growth in both countries. Indeed, in California alone, over one million jobs depend on trade with Canada and Canada-related investment activity. But while our commercial relations are basically sound, Canadians believe that “buy American” trade barriers hurt businesses in both countries, not only in terms of cross-border trade, but with regard to joint manufacturing projects. Canada hopes for more effective integration of our two highly advanced economies, and is working with Washington to harmonize business regulations and increase the security of our long border.

Consul General Doyle previously served in senior executive positions throughout the Canadian government: as Deputy Minister of Natural Resources, Associate Deputy Minister of the Environment, and one of the Directors of Canada's Atomic Energy Corporation.
