



## Santa Rosa Junior College General Education Articulation Agreement

General Education requirements are based on whether the student is enrolled in the Day or Adult Degree Completion Program (ADCP). Unless specified, Day and ADCP G.E. requirements are identical. All General Education requirements must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. A grade of "P" (Pass) will be accepted for a GE course that is completed before matriculation.

College of Marin students preparing to transfer to DUC may also take the course(s) listed below, or any approved for IGETC in the areas of Oral Communication, Math, Social and Behavioral Science, Physical and Biological Science, and Arts before transferring to DUC. The course(s) listed in each GE area below is/are acceptable for students who have already matriculated to take at College of Marin when fulfilling GE requirements. Prior approval via an Authorization to Take Courses off Campus form is required.

### First Year Experience

First Year Experience must be completed at DUC if student has 15 transferable units or less.

### Foundations - ADCP

The Foundations course must be completed at DUC.

**Writing** – Any remaining units must be taken at DUC after matriculation.
