All coursework at the community college level is considered lower division. Lower division course content may be accepted in lieu of upper division requirements at Dominican, however, students must still satisfy upper division major and graduation *unit* requirements. Courses that may be applied to both General Education and major requirements (up to 9 units) are indicated with a §. All science courses must have been completed within the past five years.
