

NURSING MAJOR ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

For a complete description of requirements for the Nursing major please refer to the Dominican University of California Catalog. General Education requirements are covered in a separate articulation and should be reviewed in conjunction with major preparation. All coursework at the community college level is considered lower division. Lower division course content may be accepted in lieu of upper division requirements at Dominican, however, students must still satisfy upper division major and graduation *unit* requirements. Courses that may be applied to both General Education and major requirements (up to 9 units) are indicated with a §.

All Nursing courses and Nursing prerequisites must be taken within the five years previous to entering Dominican.
