



General Education requirements are based on whether the student is enrolled in the Day or Adult Degree Completion Program (ADCP). Unless specified, Day and ADCP G.E. requirements are identical. All General Education requirements must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. A "P" (Pass) will be accepted for a GE course that is completed before matriculation
