Purpose and Meaning (4 units)

Any (1) course in Religious Studies disciplinary area* **OR** any of the GE Social and Personal Responsibility thematic area course

International Language (matriculation requirement)

Students with 60 units or more are exempt. Students with two years of study at the high school level with an overall 2.0 in the same language other than English have fulfilled the requirement. In addition, students who have taken any Modern Language or Culture and Language course have fulfilled the requirement.
