Program Requirements for Earning a Preliminary Single Subject Teaching Credential <u>at</u> <u>Dominican University</u> for Holders of a Valid Multiple Subject Teaching Credential:

- a. Content area subject-matter competence (CSETs). http://www.ctcexams.nesinc.com/
- b. A four-unit course in methodology directly related to teaching in a departmentalized setting in the specific content area sought. (EDU 5275, Pedagogy Preparation III)
- c. Possession of an English Learner Authorization (ELA):
 - All teacher candidates admitted to a California Multiple or Single Subject Teacher Credential Program on or after July 1, 2002 complete embedded English learner course work authorized under Assembly Bill 1059 (Chap. 711, Stats. 1999). In June 2006, an English Learner Authorization (ELA) was also embedded in the coursework for the Education Specialist Credential. These individuals earn an ELA directly on their teaching credential. - d. Complete a California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) Credential Application and processing fee. See Apply for Second Credential-CTC
