Student Health Insurance Plans are generally less expensive and have better coverage than individual plans purchased through state marketplaces.

Premiums are lower and your out of pocket costs will be low as well. Most plans are PPO's (Preferred Provider Networks), which means easy access to providers near campus or anywhere you may live or travel.
