## SAMPLE DEGREE MAP FOR NURSING BSN REQUIREMENTS – 4 Year Graduation Track

- Students in the Honors program take Honors-specific Core classes.
- Transfer students follow a somewhat different program plan for CORE requirements (see transfer course evaluation).
- Minimum grade in prerequisite and co-requisite classes is a C with the exception of Human Anatomy and Physiology (min. grade is a B).
- Minimum grade in NURS/NURL is a C+. Students who do not pass more than one class required for the nursing major (i.e., prerequisite, co-requisite, or Nursing) are disqualified from the nursing program.
- All Nursing courses in a level must be passed before progressing to the following level's Nursing courses.
- Students who do not pass a required class will be moved to the 4 ½ Year Track.
