CORE Articulation Agreement (2023-2024)

Students who have previously earned an academic associates degree from Canada College at the time of matriculation, will be waived from taking any Core courses.

Note: All courses are 4 units at Dominican University of California. Canada College 3 unit courses will meet the CORE requirement but not earn 4 units.
