CORE Articulation Agreement (2025-2026))

Students who have previously earned an academic associates degree from Canada College at the time of matriculation, will be required to take EC 2000 at Dominican University of California, but all other CORE requirements will be considered met through the AA

Note: All courses are 4 units at Dominican University of California. Canada College 3 unit courses will meet the CORE requirement but not earn 4 units. Transfer courses must earn a C or better.

Effective Communication 1 and 2 (4+4 units) - Any remaining units must be taken at DUC after matriculation
To meet both categories, student must have two English and a speech class.
