

## Doctorate in Occupational Therapy Required Evaluation of Volunteer Experience

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The Department of Occupational Therapy (OT) requires applicants for the entry-level Doctor of Occupational Therapy (OTD) program to provide evidence of occupational therapy observation/volunteer hours. The OT department will allow observation hours that were conducted in a virtual environment. More than one form may be used to document one or more settings. Applicants must provide this form as evidence of the following:

- A minimum of 20 hours of OT relevant experience spent under the supervision of an OTR (observation/ volunteer).
- Observation/volunteer hours were completed within the previous 3 years.
- Observation forms have been completed and signed by the occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant at each site.
